Frosted Pumpkin Cranberry Bars

Prep time: 15 min. Bake time: 20 min. Makes: 4 dozen

Ingredients

- 1½ cups all-purpose flour
- 1¼ cups sugar
- 2 tsp. baking powder
- 2 tsp. ground cinnamon
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- ½ tsp. ground ginger
- 3 large eggs, room temperature
- 1 can (15 ounces) solid-pack pumpkin
- ¾ cup butter, melted
- ¾ cup chopped dried cranberries

Brown Butter Frosting

- ½ cup butter
- 4 cups confectioners' sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 4 to 6 tbsp. whole milk
- Additional dried cranberries, optional

The Best Part

1. In a large bowl, combine the flour, sugar, baking powder, ground cinnamon, baking soda, and ground ginger. In a separate bowl, whisk together the eggs, pumpkin, and butter. Stir the wet mix into the dry ingredients until well combined, then stir in cranberries.

2. Spread into a greased pan measuring 15" x 10" x 1". Bake at 350° for 20-25 minutes or until a toothpick inserted into the center comes out clean. Cool on a wire rack.

3. To make the frosting, cook butter over medium heat in a large heavy saucepan for 5-7 minutes or until golden brown. Pour into a large bowl; beat in the confectioners' sugar, vanilla, and enough milk to achieve spreading consistency. Frost the bars. If desired, sprinkle finely chopped dried cranberries on top.

Propane Safety Q&A

WHAT DOES PROPANE GAS SMELL LIKE?

Propane gas is naturally odorless, but an odorant is added to help make it more detectable. It has a strong smell and resembles skunk, rotten egg, or dead animal.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I SMELL GAS?

If you suspect a gas leak, here are the steps you should take:

1. Evacuate the building, extinguishing flames and not operating any electronics or appliances.
2. If it's safe to do so, turn the supply valve on your propane tank clockwise to turn it off.
3. From a safe distance, call Roby's Gas or 911 immediately to report the leak. Do not return to your home until a propane professional has deemed it safe.
